Roheveski – Green Mill

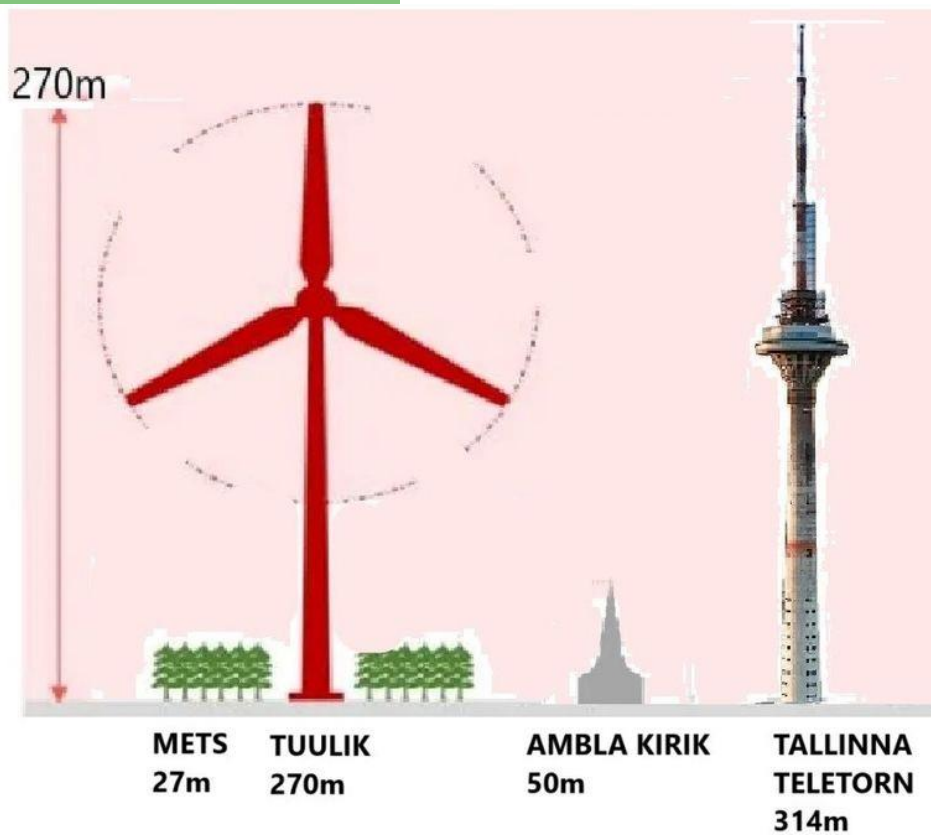
