
The birth of the AoE story

- Rural, inner-peripheral areas
- Nature-sensitive areas
- Infrastructure, industry and service-poor areas
- Lack of language skills

European Cycling Tourism trends


- ✓ The number of cyclists and the number of trips made by bicycle is growing
- ✓ Average age 53.6 (typically with a partner, alone or with a small group of friends)
- ✓ They are looking for cycling "trails" (71%), one week (7.6 days), 71
 km per day
- ✓ Motivation: new experiences, "active ageing", sustainable tourism
- ✓ E-bike use (2017: 18%, 2022: 38%) to explore longer and more adventurous routes
- ✓ Planning digital tools
- √ Importance of multimodality (rail)



The AoE innovative solutions

- Design the route
- Visitor management concept
- Branding
- Set up a booking system development of standards
- "Give back to Nature" valorisation programme
- capacity building programme
- Route: total 1250 km + other roads
- Bookable product(s) since 2022
- Goal: to increase the number of tourists (not mass tourism, but conscious and value-oriented)







ICTr-CE project – one step further

- "Once divide, now connects" Developing a crossborder cycling route
- EuroVelo 13Longest EuroVelo route (13 000 km +)
- Cultural (Iron Curtain) and natural heritages (2003: European Green Belt)
- 2014: Iron Curtain Trail project
- 2019: Iron Curtain Cycle Route as a "European Cultural Route"
- 2023: The ICTr-CE project

- Developing an innovative, collaborative business and management model
- Developing bookable cycling packages
- Include innovative elements
 - carbon footprint calculator (Carmacal)
 - Impact measurement system (Tailor-made IMS)
 - The Good Impact programme a valorization programme to lower the negative impact caused by tourists



As a summary

- Rural, peripheral areas → challenges
- Sustainable tourism is key
- Set up a basis for tourists (concious, sustainable)
 - Involve local actors
 - Build on your USP (stories, local products, experiences)
 - Be unique and innovative
 - Build-up a sustainable business model
