- **Our Guiding Theme - Connecting Local Action to EU Ideals**


For North Corfu, sustainable transport is not just an environmental goal; it is a commitment to:

- Social Cohesion & Equity (A Fundamental Right): Ensuring all residents and visitors, regardless of age, ability, or income, can access our island's opportunities.
- Territorial Cohesion (An EU Value): Bridging the gap between remote villages and central services, strengthening our connection to the European community.
- Participatory Democracy (An EU Value): Engaging our citizens in the decisions that shape their mobility and their environment.

North Corfu in a Nutshell: A Living Laboratory

Key Characteristics:

- ✓ **Geography:** A blend of coastal hubs, mountainous villages, & remote peninsulas.
- ✓ **Economy:** Heavily reliant on seasonal tourism, with a backbone of local fisheries and agriculture.
- ✓ **The Core Challenge:** A transportation system under pressure from seasonality, geographic fragmentation, & the need to protect a fragile ecosystem..



Our Foundation: A Proven Commitment to Sustainability

The Green Award 2021:

1st Prize in Greece for "Recycling Programme with sorting at source."

- **What it Demonstrates:**
 - **Proactive Environmental Leadership:** We don't just follow policies; we create exemplars.
 - **Successful Community Engagement:** We built a network of 104 recycling centres in collaboration with schools, hotels, and NGOs.
 - **A Culture of Sustainability:** This award proves our community is ready and willing to participate in ambitious green initiatives, including sustainable mobility.



A Strategic Leap Forward - The Small Ports Management Office

- **The Challenge:** Our vital small ports (Kassiopi, Sidari, Agios Stefanos, etc.) suffer from fragmented management, safety issues, and a lack of basic services.
- **Our Innovative Solution:** The establishment of a **centralized Small Ports Management Office**.
- **Strategic Aims:**
 - Unified, professional management.
 - Enhanced safety and security for all users.
 - Efficient use of revenues and pursuit of EU funding.
 - Environmental protection of the coastal zone.



A Strategic Leap Forward - The Small Ports Management Office



Linking Ports to the GreenMove Vision - Our Concrete Proposals

How the Ports Management Office becomes the engine for sustainable mobility and EU values:

Initiative	Direct Impact on Mobility & Values
1. Electrification of Ports	Install charging stations for electric vessels and vehicles. Value: Environmental Protection & Innovation.
2. "Last-Mile" Connectivity	Integrate port arrivals with EV shuttle services, bike-sharing hubs, and accessible pathways. Value: Social Inclusion & Territorial Cohesion.
3. Digital "Mobility Hub"	A single app for info on ferry schedules, EV rentals, and bike availability. Value: Access to Information as a Right.
4. Community-Led "Port Sustainability Charters"	Engage fishermen, tour operators, and residents in creating shared rules for waste management (linking to our Green Award success) and low-noise operations. Value: Participatory Democracy.



Realistic Scenarios & Proposals for a Greener North Corfu

- **Proposal 1: The "Kassiopi Circular Tour"**
 - **Scenario:** A boat arrives at the newly managed Kassiopi port.
 - **Solution:** Tourists disembark and are guided to a dedicated hub for e-bike rentals, electric minibuses, and mapped routes to local businesses and cultural sites, reducing congestion and emissions.



Realistic Scenarios & Proposals for a Greener North Corfu

- **Proposal 2: The "Inclusive Acharavi Corridor"**
 - **Scenario:** An elderly resident or a family with a stroller needs to travel from a village to the coast.
 - **Solution:** Develop a scheduled, accessible electric shuttle service connecting the Acharavi Folklore Museum area with nearby beaches, ensuring safe and dignified access for all.



Realistic Scenarios & Proposals for a Greener North Corfu

- **Proposal 3: "Adopt-a-Path" Community Program**

- **Scenario:** Maintaining and signposting scenic walking/cycling paths between villages.
- **Solution:** A civic engagement program where local communities and businesses "adopt" a path, ensuring its upkeep and promoting active, zero-emission mobility.
