



Special stickers or signs „Cyklisté vítáni“ where the cyclers are welcome



The "Cyclists Welcome Sticker" refers to a sticker marking facilities, such as accommodation or restaurants, that are certified under the Cyclists Welcome scheme of the Partnership Foundation. These facilities offer services for cyclists, such as secure bike parking, basic tools, laundry facilities and e-bike charging. The sign takes the form of a green and white logo with a smiling bicycle and serves to identify quality cycling services.

Sustainable Tourism

The **Pochod tří hradů** is a **traditional annual hiking event** in the **Ústí nad Orlicí region**, held since **1973**.

It connects three historical castles:

Lanšperk Castle

Žampach Castle

Potštejn Castle

Participants can choose from various walking routes (often between 10–50 km) and enjoy beautiful nature, historical sites, and local hospitality.

Sustainable Tourism

In the vicinity of Ústí nad Orlicí, EU funds were used for cycle paths in several projects, for example within the framework of the ROP Northeast, which made it possible to build a cycle path from Žamberk to Letohrad, and also to support the construction of other sections in the region, including the future connection of Lanškrounsko and Českořebovsko. These funds helped to expand and improve the cycle path network, increase safety and fluidity of traffic and support the development of cycling tourism in the region.
