


# BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA- rural area



# City of Livno – Between Tradition and Potential

---



- ▶ The City of Livno is located in the southwest of Bosnia and Herzegovina, covering an area of approximately 994 km<sup>2</sup> and home to around 30,000 inhabitants. It includes a large number of rural settlements scattered across mountainous and karst landscapes.
- ▶ Livno is known for its natural beauty, mountains, rivers, lakes, karst fields and wild horses that attract visitors, but it also faces challenges related to access to public services, transport connectivity, and energy resources.
- ▶ This combination makes Livno an ideal candidate for developing sustainable solutions in rural settings.



# Achievements So Far – Mobility

- Over 100 kilometers of bicycle paths are marked with road signs and information boards
- One company in the city of Livno offers the possibility of renting electric bicycles, which is a novelty on the local market in the last few years.
- Furthermore, several local companies are offer a different assortment of bicycles (from exclusive ones for off-road riding to smaller dimensions and smaller wheel sizes).
- Bus lines are provided at twice a day in almost all villages in the Livno area
- Local company Li-Taxi, whose fleet has hybrid vehicles (city driving on electricity, while open and at higher speeds it uses gasoline)



# Kruzi mountains - The most famous tourist attraction

---

- Plateau that extends above Livno at an average altitude of 1400 m
- Habitat of wild horses (over 900 according to estimates)
- The most famous tourist attraction Livno
- Tourists are offered transportation to the plateau and visits to wild horses.
- Transportation is offered by quads and jeeps.



# Kruzi mountains and initiatives

- Increase in the number of initiatives for jeeps as a means of transportation towards the plateau and wild horses
- Quads create too much noise and due to the larger number of vehicles, there is greater environmental pollution (primarily CO<sub>2</sub> emissions)
- Initiatives to protect Kruzi mountain



# Livno – Development Directions and Future Opportunities

- **Main goal:** environmental protection Kruzi mountain and creation of sustainable tourism due to the increasing number of tourists
- Constant increase in the number of tourists in Livno who visit Krug mountain and wild horses but in a sustainable way
- **Linking tourism with sustainable mobility:** creating more tourist routes accessible by bike or foot.
- **Partnerships for EU projects:** through GreenMove, Interreg, and other programs.
